Basil A. Newton, 81 year old long time resident of Siskiyou County, passed away peacefully at his home in Montague on Saturday, July 11 2020, following a long-term illness. He was surrounded by family and friends.

Basil was born in Nyssa, Oregon to Basil E. Newton and Ida Newton (Wagner) on May 5, 1939. He and his family moved to Mt. Shasta in 1945. Basil attended Mt. Shasta Elementary School and graduated from Mt. Shasta High School in 1957. Basil rose to the enviable level of Eagle Scout as a member of the Boy Scouts of America. Following high school, Basil joined the National Guard.

Basil married his wife, Wilma (Smith) in 1959, settling in Montague. Basil and Wilma had two children, Teresa Newton of Montague and Terri Barham (Kirk) of Big Springs. Basil worked on local farms and ranches. He eventually began building custom homes and raising his own registered Angus cattle. Basil was enthusiastic about the local community, especially focused on the local youth involvement in agriculture. His attendance at the Siskiyou Golden Fair, Red Bluff and Klamath Falls Bull sales will be missed.

Basil was preceded in death by his wife, Wilma and brother Clarence. Basil leaves behind his daughters, Teresa and Terri; Tomi Jackson, who he considered as his daughter; his brother Roger, along with numerous nieces, nephews and friends. A celebration of life will be held at the Montague Rodeo grounds on Sunday, August 9th at 5:00 PM. In lieu of flowers, the family is establishing a scholarship in Basil's name.
