



## Ada Louise Vivier

June 10, 1931 - January 24, 2017

Ada Louise Vivier, for many years known as Ada Dodd, a long-time Siskiyou County resident, passed away on Tuesday, January 24, 2017 in an assisted living facility in Medford, Ore. following a long illness.

Ada was born June 10, 1931 in Winters to John and Alma Rice and grew up in the Winters and Sebastopol areas. She married David Dodd in 1958. The couple had 2 sons, Kevin and Peter, and as David was a pastor, the family moved and served in several churches in California and Oregon. After David left the family, Ada moved with her 2 boys to Hornbrook in 1971 where she had found a job as a 3rd & 4th grade teacher at the Hornbrook Elementary School. After teaching for several years, she went to work for the Siskiyou County Office of Education. She went back to Chico State, where she had originally received her lifetime teaching credential, and received her Master's Degree. She was a member the Hornbrook Community Bible Church for 46 years. Ada's faith was central to her life and serving in the church occupied much of her life. She would want all to find the hope, joy and peace she found in Jesus. She was also involved in Child Evangelism Fellowship and Phi Beta Kappa for many years.

In July 1991, she married Vince Vivier and continued to live in the Hornbrook area until health issues forced them to move to Medford. Vince passed away on November 15th of last year.

Ada is survived by her son, Peter, a missionary in Taiwan; 2 step sons, Kirt and Vince Vivier Jr., both of the Bay Area; 5 grandchildren and a step

granddaughter. In addition to Vince, Ada was preceded in death by her son, Kevin, and her brother, Albert Rice.
