Alan Johns passed away peacefully on October 7th 2013 in Yreka, California at the age of 81. Alan was born in Denver, Colorado. He grew up in the Salt Lake City area before moving to the San Francisco Bay area. Alan served in the US Navy for over 20 years as a naval aviator flying anti-submarine aircraft off aircraft carriers and then as a Computer Systems Analyst, retiring at the rank of Lieutenant Commander.
