Alan was born in Yreka, August 13, 1934, growing up in Little Shasta Valley until his parents moved to Trinity where both he and his dad worked on a gold dredge. After graduating from Trinity High School, he attended Shasta College for a short time then enlisted in the Army. After finishing his term with the Army, he went to Oregon Institute of Technology where he graduated from the Diesel program. In 1961 he married Nancy Myers and they moved to Crescent City for several years, both his children were born in Crescent City.

He moved his family to Redding for a short time and then went into road construction where he worked for Kiewit for most of his work life. He left Kiewit for 8 years and worked for Siskiyou County Road Department during the years his daughter and son attended Yreka High School. He returned to road construction, during the time he was working in road construction he worked in Washington, Oregon, Hawaii, and Nevada until he retired. After retirement he and Nancy traveled by RV and took several cruises. When not traveling he enjoyed working "on the place" in Little Shasta.
