Alice Jane Brandon, 85, was born 28th of November 1938 to Quincy and Evelyn Hammond at the Siskiyou General Hospital. She passed away in the afternoon on the 13th of May of 2024 at Fairchild Medical Center after a lengthy illness.

She spent many trips to the family cabin in the Marbles. Alice was a member of Yreka No.19 Independent Order of Odd Fellows.

Alice was married three times and had four children; Mary (Ray) Nebergall, Kathryn (Dick) Aldrich, Wayne Clark, and Alfred (Mireya) Brandon. She also had three stepchildren from her marriage to Urban Elmer Brandon Jr: Urban Danniell (Shawna) Brandon, Robert Brandon, and Anna Hueston. She also had several grandchildren; Ethan Aldrich, Natalie (Adam) Miller, Kaitlyn
