



## Alois "Louie" Arnold

October 15, 1926 - October 9, 2019

Longtime Siskiyou County resident Louie Arnold passed away at Madrone Hospice in Yreka on October 7, 2019. He was 92 years old.

Louie was born in Burglen, Switzerland on October 15, 1926 to a family of nine children. Louie and a cousin migrated to California in 1949, and he became a proud naturalized citizen in 1955. Originally, he lived and worked in the Woodland, California area, but eventually moved to Siskiyou County.

Louie worked in dairies, lumber mills and ranches. He resided for many years with his longtime loving partner, Peggy Sidner, who predeceased him in 2010. Louie visited his family in Switzerland over the years, and Peggy was able to accompany him on one of those trips. In 2015, Louie moved to Shepherd of God (Grenada Gardens), where he resided until his death.

Louie leaves many family members in Switzerland as well as cousins in California. He will be buried alongside Peggy in a graveside service at Evergreen Cemetery in Yreka on Friday, November 1, 2019 at 1:00 PM. Rest in peace, Louie.
