



## Anita Marta Norman

June 9, 1942 - October 22, 2015

Longtime Hornbrook resident Anita Marta Norman, age 73, passed away October 22, 2015 at her home.

Anita was born on June 9, 1942 in Stettin-Politz, Germany to Eugen and Elisabeth Zoller. The family was separated, and Anita and her mother, after escaping the Russians, were interned in Denmark. Anita was raised in Germany and Spain before the family returned to her hometown of Ludwigshafen-Oppau.

In 1962 she met Frank Norman, and he and Anita were married on October the 15th in Reno, Nevada. They lived in Yreka for several years when Frank was assigned to the US Army Recruiting station, then located on Butte Street. After Frank retired from the US Army in 1985, they moved back to Siskiyou County. Anita was a teller at Tri Counties Bank for many years and a member of the ladies bowling league at Siskiyou Lanes in Yreka. She enjoyed traveling and taking care of her family, especially her husband and her grandchildren.

Anita is survived by her husband of 53 years, Frank Norman; two daughters, Jeanette Daniels of Fort Worth, Texas and Michele Ochs of San Antonio, Texas; a brother, Gerhard Zoller of Germany; and two grandchildren, Danielle and Michael Ochs.

Funeral services will be held on Friday, October 30, 2015 at St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Yreka, with the recitation of the rosary at 10:30 AM, followed by the Mass of Christian Burial at 11:00 AM.
