



Arthur "Art" Hausauer

March 30, 1927 - October 6, 2014

Arthur F. Hausauer, a longtime resident of Fort Jones, passed away at his home in Lacombe, Oregon, on Monday, Oct. 6, 2014. He was 87.

Art was born on March 30, 1927, in Santa Ana, California, to Arthur Hausauer and Edna Mae Fowler Hausauer.

Art grew up on the family ranch in El Toro, California. He attended the small elementary school in El Toro and then graduated from Tustin High school and later joined the Army in 1950. During this time he married his girl, Edie Kitto, on June 26, 1951. After his discharge from the Army, he and Edie returned to El Toro to the family ranch to continue his love of working the ranch. Art also worked at the Brookhurst Feed Mill in Riverside, California, for 25 years, until he retired in 1978. That same year, Art and Edie moved to Fort Jones, where Art continued to raise cattle and farm. They made one last move in 2005, to Lacombe, Oregon, where they continued to camp and go to the coast with friends.

Art was a lifelong rancher. He was a member of the El Toro Volunteer Fire Department and a lifelong member of the Elks. Art loved hunting, fishing, camping and going to the coast. He enjoyed reading and playing pinochle.

Art is survived by his wife of 63 years, Edie; daughter, Judy Wilson, and

husband, Kim of Vancouver, Washington; son, Jim, and wife, Maureen of Fort Jones; grandchildren, Dustin Wilson of Las Vegas, Brooke Bertran of Trabuco Canyon, California, and Ryan and Jimmy Hausauer of Fort Jones; and two great-grandchildren.

A memorial service will be held at Girdner Funeral Chapel in Yreka on Wednesday, Oct. 22, 2014, at 3 p.m. All are invited to a reception afterward at the Fort Jones Community Hall.
