



Barbara Horne

May 15, 1923 - January 20, 2015

91 year old Hornbrook resident, Barbara Horne, Mom, passed away peacefully on January 20, 2015 at her home surrounded by her family.

Barbara was born to Samuel and Edna Palmer on May 15, 1923 in Long Beach, where she spent most of her adolescent years. She had one brother, Warren Palmer, who preceded her in death. During this time the family moved to Montesano, Washington, where she spent most of her high school years. She told many stories about going to the beach and digging for clams or collecting oysters. The family then moved back to Long Beach until she traveled to New Jersey. Mom lived there a short time and once again returned to Long Beach. During the war years, Mom worked for one of the aircraft plants and loved to tell how she had a secret clearance and worked in the "Vault" with all kinds of classified material.

Mom met the "Love of her Life," John Horne upon his return from active duty in Europe after being wounded in Belgium and receiving the Bronze Star and Purple Heart. They dated for a short time and then eloped to Yuma, Arizona to be married on November 27, 1945. Mom spent the next 40 years with Dad in their one and only Long Beach home raising her two boys, Michael and Gary. Finally, with the boys gone and living in retirement, they moved to Hornbrook, where they set up housekeeping again for the next 23 years. She was active with the Yreka Elkettes and spent much time on the Klamath River at the R-

Ranch, where she enjoyed her son's families.

Mom is survived by her husband, John; her two sons, Michael and Grace Horne, and Gary and Linda Horne. She has four grandchildren, 14 great-grandchildren (and one on the way) along with numerous nieces and nephews. Mom has now made one last move to her eternal home in Heaven where she will be waiting to greet her friends and family when they arrive.

Funeral services for Barbara will be held on Wednesday, January 28, 2015, at 1:00 p.m. at Girdner Funeral Chapel in Yreka.
