Lifelong Siskiyou County resident Betty Lou Hall passed away peacefully at her Mugginsville home on May 19, 2021 with family and friends at her side. She was 86 years old.

Betty was the only daughter of Fred Lee Wicks and Nina Elisabeth Kintano Wicks. Her husband, Roy Victor Hall Sr., preceded her in death. Roy and Betty had seven children: Brenda (Ron) Brodmerkle of Athol, Idaho, Linda (Victor) Navarro, Mary (Eric) Carpelan, Bill (Tracy) Hall of Yreka, Roy (Monica) Hall Jr. of Mugginsville, Nina (Charles) Cossey of Etna and Glenn (Carolyn) Hall of Fort Jones. She also leaves seventeen grandchildren, thirty-eight great grandchildren and six great-great grandchildren.

Betty was a member of the Torres Martinez Desert Cahuilla Reservation and a lifelong historian for the Shasta Nation. Betty had an associate's degree in accounting, and was a member of the Cambridge Who's Who of America. She collected wild flowers and was a traditional native herbalist. She was also very active in the local cultural concerns.
