Bonnie E. Fowler, a wonderful mother, grandmother and aunt passed away in Redding, CA January 18, 2012 at the age of 92.

Bonnie was born on December 27, 1919 in Etna, CA to Frank and May Boedecker. Bonnie resided most of her life in Etna. She retired from Siskiyou Telephone Company, at the age of eighty one and moved to Palo Cedro, CA to be closer to her children and grandchildren.
