Carl Joseph Mayr of Hornbrook passed into the arms of our Lord on September 9, 2021. Born on March 27, 1930 in San Francisco to Karl and Vera Mayr, Carl grew up in the Bay Area until he joined the United States Navy in 1948, serving four years as an Airedale Mechanic.

Carl married his life's love, Dolores, on November 14, 1953 at Saint Charles Catholic Church in San Francisco. Together they had two children, Carl Vincent Mayr and Craig Vernon Mayr. As a family they enjoyed camping, fishing and water skiing.

Carl was a proud Teamster, driving trucks throughout the Bay Area for 40 years until his retirement in 1989. He and Dolores moved to Hornbrook after his retirement. Carl enjoyed his home, spending many hours watching the birds and the weather from the best seat in the house. He had a great appreciation of classical music, his favorite song being the Irish classic "Danny Boy." His hobbies included reading and watching movies about World War II, gardening and sneaking treats to his spoiled dogs.

Carl and Dolores shared 68 years of marriage. Together they went on special trips, enjoying Alaska, Hawaii and China. They celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary with loved ones in Reno, Nevada. The couple renewed their wedding vows on their 65th anniversary at Saint Joseph's Catholic Church in

Yreka.

Carl is preceded in death by his parents, children and sister, Sylvia Ellis. He is survived by his loving wife, Dolores; nephew Bob Ellis; daughter-in-law Doreen Mayr; and three generations of grandchildren.
