



## Carrie Lee Morgan

May 21, 1942 - February 2, 2012

On Thursday, February 2, 2012, Carrie Lee Morgan went to be with her Lord and Savior at the age of 69. She passed peacefully at Madrone Hospice in the company of her family.

Carrie was born in Inglewood, California on May 21, 1942 to Lee and Fern Mushett. They moved to Greenview, California in 1946 when she was 4 years old. She attended Greenview Elementary, then Etna High School for three years before moving to Yreka where she attended her senior year.
