Charles Allen Brown, better known as "Buck," passed away at his home in McConaughy Gulch on June 16, 2019 after a lengthy illness.

Buck was born in John Day, Oregon on September 1, 1938 to William E. and Emma Mackey Brown. He is survived by two children, Elaine Brown Nielson and Charles Andrew "Andy" Brown; a brother William "Buddy" Brown; his beloved canine daughter, Lucky; and his companion of 50+ years, Jackie Denny.
