Chris was raised in the Vallejo/American Canyon and graduated from Vintage High School. Chris joined the U.S. Navy when he turned 18 years old, serving his country as an Operations Specialist, Third Class, and he left with honors.

Chris worked various jobs after discharging from the Navy, but stopped working due to his health. Chris enjoyed playing games, including MAGIC The Gathering, board, video and computer games. Chris loved superheroes, and collected comic books. Chris also loved sports. His favorite teams were the Los Angeles Lakers and the Oakland A's.
