October 10, 1937 - March 16, 2017

Longtime Scott Valley resident, Clara "Arlene" Anderson, passed away on Thursday, March 16, 2017 at Fairchild Medical Center in Yreka. She was 79 years old.

Arlene was born to Hurlburt and Rosalie Dickinson on October 10, 1937 in Long Beach, California. She spent most of her time growing up in Scott Valley, and was crowned Miss Etna during high school. She and her husband, Clyde, owned and operated a roofing company for many years, and Arlene spent many years managing a beauty salon in Sacramento.

After Clyde passed away in 1999, Arlene returned to Etna. She was very active in the Callahan Community Church in Callahan, where she served as treasurer until her passing.
