Clell Krout, long time Yreka resident, passed away peacefully on Thursday Sept. 5th 2019 at his home surrounded by love. Clell was born in Orchards, Washington on November 2nd, 1934 and moved with his young family to Yreka in 1964, where he continued working for Pacific Power and Light running the warehouse until his retirement in 1992. He was with PP&L for 37 years.

As a young man, Clell enjoyed playing men's fast-pitch softball at Miner Street Park where his family could be found cheering him on every weekend (and many weeknights) during softball season. He was also part of the Yreka Volunteer Fire Dept. and during the winter months was on a bowling league team at Siskiyou Bowling Lanes.

Clell loved hunting and fishing, especially his hunting trips to Montana with his buddy, Milo, where they would get both elk and mule deer.

Clell leaves behind 5 children, Judy Frenick Michels (stepdaughter), Dana Krout, Jody Krout Hoover, Pam Krout Walther, and Jodi Frenick Black (stepdaughter), 15 grandchildren and 29 great grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his wife Charlotte Russell Krout (1993) and a stepson Mitch Frenick (1973).

Clell was the youngest of 10 children and the last to pass. He was a quiet,

generous man who enjoyed staying home, working in his garden, and watching the deer in his yard. One of Clell's greatest joys came from having his children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren swim in his pool. He will be greatly missed.
