



Clinton Leo Morey

June 13, 1913 - March 6, 2011

Clinton Leo Morey, 97, passed away on March 6, 2011 at his residence in Yreka.

Clint was born on June 13, 1913 in Kerbyville, Oregon to Elmer Garfield Morey and Rhoda Bell (Wimer) Morey. He was one of seven brothers and sisters.

After graduating from Roseburg High School in 1932, he joined the Civilian Conservation Corps, working as a logger and construction laborer in Northern California. He then moved on to become a police officer for the city of Dunsmuir. Following the events of December 1941, he enlisted in the U.S. Army, becoming a railroad engineer. He returned from overseas at the end of World War II and went to work as an engineer for Southern Pacific Railway out of Klamath Falls until his retirement in 1974.

Clint met his future wife Alice Virginia Meeder in 1950 and they were married in 1951. Following his retirement, Clint and Virginia moved from Klamath Falls to Brookings, followed by a move to Dunsmuir before finally settling down in Yreka.

Clint is survived by his wife of 60 years, Virginia; a sister, Thelma Haskins of Roseburg, OR; daughter Lynn Young of Dunsmuir; son and daughter-in-law Marvin and Ellen Morey of Klamath Falls; granddaughter and husband Cindy and Dennis Wilson of Weed; granddaughter and husband Chris and Stewart Cox of Dunsmuir; granddaughter and husband Lisa and Scott Hubbard of Dunsmuir; granddaughter and husband Stacie and Joe Sicilia of Moses Lake,

Washington; grandson and wife Clinton and Kaycee Morey of Naval Air Station in LeMoore; eight great grandchildren and six great great grandchildren.
