Cora Elizabeth Madole went to be with her Heavenly Father on June 18th, 2018. She was born on January 25th, 1930 in Atchinson County, Missouri to Lester and Ruth Smith. Cora lived in Hamburg, Iowa before moving to Pomona, California in 1933. Cora graduated from Chino High School and married her high school sweetheart Orin "Doc" Madole on August 24th, 1947. They were married for 61 and a half years. She moved with her husband and family to Scott Valley in 1973 and then to Montague in 1989. Throughout these years she supported her husband in farming, providing many enjoyable noon meals to workers. Cora resided in Montague until her passing and greatly enjoyed the company of her neighbors Velma and Cliff Rodgers and Carolyn Houghton.

Cora was a devoted wife and a woman of the Lord. She took great satisfaction in preparing meals and desserts for members of her church, her community, and for every holiday gathering.
