Starting with a part-time job at Montague Elementary School to be more involved in the school her daughters attended, she went on to make a career out of impacting the lives of every young person she came into contact with. Over the course of several decades, Cindy worked at several daycares, the Adult Learning Center, Montague Elementary, Delphic Elementary, and College of the Siskiyous. She also returned to school herself and completed a Bachelor's degree in Psychology at the age of 50.

Cindy found herself very funny, and most people agreed. She loved to laugh, even through the toughest of times; nobody could make you laugh like Cindy.

Cindy was a champion of the underdog, a reflection of her desire as a young person to pursue a career as a probation officer and her own colorful youth. If

Cindy had an empty room in her house or snacks in her fridge, they were available to anyone in need. She found significant meaning in her faith and her relationship with God, and was a founding member of Shasta Valley Christian Fellowship in Montague.

Cindy was immensely proud of her family. She described motherhood as her crowning achievement, particularly the people her daughters grew up to be and the people her grandkids were growing into. She loved family vacations at the beach, family reunions in the Redwoods, and particularly good sandwiches.
