



Daniel Joseph Hunt

September 7, 1947 - February 27, 2022

Longtime Fort Jones resident, Daniel Joseph Hunt, passed away on February 27, 2022 at Fairchild Medical Center in Yreka. He was 74 years old.

Daniel was born on September 7, 1947 to Harold (Mike) and Elizabeth (Betty) Pouriea-Hunt in South Dakota. They moved to Siskiyou County in 1965.

Daniel served in the United States Army after graduating from high school, during that service time he married Diana Lee Cramer on April 21, 1967.

Daniel worked for the United States Forest Service for almost 40 years. He started as a wildland firefighter before becoming a fire prevention officer.

Daniel was very involved in Fort Jones life: he served as a volunteer firefighter at Fort Jones Fire Department, was a longtime member of the Fort Jones City Council, and coached Little League for many years. When not at work, he could be found fishing for bass at Trinity Lake, or salmon off the coast. If he wasn't there, you could find him on a golf course, wherever his golf group went.

Daniel was preceded in death by his parents, a daughter, Stefanie, and a great granddaughter, Sofia. He is survived by his wife of 54 years, Diana; his son, Steven (& Kelly) Hunt of Redding; son-in-law, Brian Linsley; 5 grandchildren: Erin, Austin, Jordan, Emily, and Adam; and by three siblings, Sharon Howe, Diana Berry and his brother Mike Hunt.

A memorial service will be held for Daniel at a date yet to be determined.
