



David Price Freeman

March 31, 1937 - November 21, 2015

Longtime Yreka resident David Price Freeman peacefully passed away at his Yreka home on November 21, 2015 with his family at his side. He was 78 years old.

David was born on March 31, 1937 in Hollywood to Pelkah B. "Peck" and Ora Freeman. He was a popular cheerleader at Yreka High School, and graduated in 1955. David served in the U.S. Air Force in the late 1950's. He worked at Cooley and Pollard's after his military service, then worked as a manager and troubleshooter in the restaurant business for Sambo's, Kentucky Fried Chicken and IHOP around the country. He also owned a convenience store in Klamath Falls and worked in the auto parts industry in Washington and Northern California, based in Yreka, before retiring. David was a past Exalted Ruler of Yreka Elks Lodge 1980.
