



## Dianne Virginia Wilson

Dianne Virginia Wilson passed away on August 1, 2012 at her boyfriend Gary's house in Etna following a long illness with him by her side.

Dianne was born to Brenton and Ruth Wilson on March 10, 1954 in San Gabriel, CA. She was raised amongst her two siblings Tom and Barbara. Throughout the years, Dianne would substitute teach or tutor various children. Dianne was a very active member of our community. Many hours of her time were donated as a reading and math tutor for the adult literacy program.

Dianne had an outgoing personality and a vivacious love for life. She loved to travel and always wanted to visit Europe but never quite made it that far. She was very loving and caring towards others always putting her friends and family before herself. She had a good sense of humor which showed from time to time when she would out fish her boyfriend, Gary, while on their bass

fishing trips.

She was predeceased by her parents, Brent & Ruth Wilson and her siblings, Tom and Barbara Wilson.
