



## Donna Jean Hardin

February 21, 1935 - October 4, 2016

Longtime Siskiyou County resident, Donna Jean Hardin, passed away unexpectedly on October 4, 2016 at her home in Etna. She was 81 years old, and a 52 year resident of Siskiyou County.

Donna was born on February 21, 1935 to Gilford and Lois Johnston in San Diego, California. Donna worked for the United States Navy at Naval Air Station North Island in San Diego and Naval Air Station Miramar for six years. Donna also worked for the United States Forest Service in the Klamath National Forest for 26 years as a clerk. During her time in the Klamath area, she married Roy Hardin in 1962, and the couple lived in Sawyers Bar, and later in Etna. Roy passed away in 1996.

Donna enjoyed reading, especially about history; she enjoyed walking through the woods on old logging roads. She referred to herself as a boring person, but that which we would find interesting, she wouldn't tell us, as it would be too "colorful" to publish!

Donna was preceded in death by her husband, Roy; her brothers Bruce and Kern Johnston; and her parents.
