



Dorothy Sybil Mallory

August 16, 1932 - September 21, 2014

Longtime Siskiyou County resident, Dorothy Sybil Mallory, passed away on September 21, 2014, in Grenada after a long battle with Alzheimer's disease. She was 82 years old.

Dorothy was born on August 16, 1932 in San Francisco to Charles and Fae Johnson. In March of 1953, Dorothy married her husband of the past 61 years, Thomas Mallory. Thomas was a Merchant Marine, and the couple moved around a lot; previously living in Martinez before moving to Siskiyou County in 1970.

Dorothy was very much a home maker to her husband and four children, and in the family's time moving from place to place, Dorothy enjoyed attending a wide variety of churches in a variety of towns. She was a well-established Pinochle player, and belonged to Card Clubs in Martinez, Copco, and at the Senior Center in Yreka. She continued playing Pinochle until just a couple of years ago. Dorothy was also a Certified Nurse's Assistant, and worked at several elderly care facilities, including in Monterey, Walnut Creek, and at Beverly Manor in Yreka.

Dorothy was preceded in death by her parents, one of her sons, Rick Mallory, and a grandson, Charles, Jr. She is survived by three children, Charles and Sharon Mallory of Yreka, Kathleen and Steven Espinoza of Aromas, California, and Thomas Mallory, Jr. of Las Vegas; her brother, Alan Johnson of Byron, California; five grandchildren: Nicole, Misty, Randi, Sara, and Carrie; seven great grandchildren; and her good friends, Jerry and Martha Carter, of

Martinez.
