



Dorothy Viola Eastlick Reynolds

March 2, 1926 - March 13, 2016

Dorothy Viola Eastlick Reynolds, a Scott Valley native, passed away on March 13, 2016 at Madrone Hospice in Yreka after a brief illness. She was 90 years old.

Dorothy was born in the family home in Quartz Valley on March 2, 1926 to Lester and Irene Eastlick. She started school at the Meamber Schoolhouse and later graduated the 8th grade from Quartz Valley Elementary. Her class helped raise the money to carve the large rock that sat at the entrance to Quartz Valley Elementary School. She attended Etna High School and graduated there in 1943. She then moved to Berkeley to attend Armstrong School of Business and upon completion of the classes moved back to the valley where she worked at Scott Valley Bank until her marriage.

On February 14, 1947 she married Robert "Sut" Reynolds. They resided in their home in Fort Jones where they raised their three kids for 50 years until Sut's passing in August of 1997.
