



Edward LeRoy Frederick

September 18, 1928 - February 5, 2020

Longtime local businessman Ed Frederick passed away peacefully, surrounded by his family, on February 5, 2020 at the age of 91.

Ed was born in Havre, Montana on September 18, 1928 and moved to Washington State as a teen. He met his wife, Bunny, in CleElum, Washington, when he was only 18 years old. Since they both loved to ride horses and dance, they were married a year later.

After working in the coal mines, being a meat cutter, and farming to support his young family, they moved to Willow Creek where he farmed. Needing extra money, he started driving a log truck for Fruit Growers. Discovering his love for trucks, he bought his first one in 1955. Ed and his family moved to Yreka and he began building his fleet of log trucks until 1984. Then he and his son expanded to the logging side of the business which lasted for 30 years. Upon retiring from logging, he continued trucking and hauled his last load of logs at the age of 89.

Ed was an avid outdoorsman who loved hunting, fishing, snowmobiling and waterskiing. He traveled the world with his wife and children and loved discovering new sights and experiences. He was a lifetime member of the Elks Lodge.

Ed leaves behind his wife, Minnie (Bunny); son Rick (Mary); daughter Debbie (Dave); nine grandchildren, 33 great grandchildren and 15 great-great grandchildren.

A visitation will be held on Tuesday, February 11, 2020 from 4:00 PM to 6:00 PM at Girdner Funeral Chapel in Yreka. Funeral services will be held on Wednesday, February 12, 2020 at 1:00 PM at Girdner Funeral Chapel. Interment will follow at Evergreen Cemetery.
