



## Elizabeth "Libby" Ann Moyer

February 4, 1955 - April 2, 2020


Longtime Yreka resident Elizabeth Ann "Libby" Moyer unexpectedly passed away on April 2, 2020 at her home. She was 65 years old.

Libby was born on February 4, 1955 in Tampa, Florida to Richard and Betty Moyer. The family moved to Yreka when Libby was young, and she graduated from Yreka High School. In 1974, Libby was named "Miss Yreka." Libby was a waitress and bartender for several restaurants and bars around town, including Sambos, Mings, the Jolly Club and Log Cabin. She also worked at Mt. Shasta Title for a number of years. Libby was a member of the Yreka Lion's Club, and volunteered for Purr Angels. She enjoyed gardening and making beaded jewelry, including bracelets and earrings.

Libby is survived by her mother, Betty Moyer, and four siblings: Rebecca Benton (Joe) of McLean, Virginia, Richard Moyer (Monica) of Carson City, Nevada, Charles Moyer (Deb) of Carson City, and Bill Moyer (Heather) of Mount Shasta.

No services are scheduled at this time. Libby will be interred in Evergreen Cemetery.
