



## Elvin Winchester Paul

March 16, 1950 - May 10, 2016

Longtime Montague resident Elvin Winchester Paul passed away peacefully on the morning of May 10, 2016 surrounded by family after a long and brave battle. He was 66 years old.

Elvin was born on March 16, 1950 in Florence, Oregon to Arnold and Irene Paul. He was the sixth of eleven siblings. The family moved to Siskiyou County in 1951 and settled in Montague. Elvin attended Montague Elementary and Yreka High School, graduating in 1968.
