



## Everett O. Greenley

June 15, 1931 - June 15, 2015

EVERETT O. GREENLEY passed away peacefully on June 15, 2015 (his birthday) at his home in Montague. He just recently moved back to Montague from Crescent City after 23 years. He was 84 years old.

Everett was born June 15, 1931 to Ansel and Mary (Maddux) in Colorado Springs, CO. He was the youngest of 5 children: Robert, Lela, Betty and William. The family moved to Roseburg, OR when Everett was 5 years old.

In 1951, Everett enlisted in the United States Navy during the Korean War. He was one of the original members of the UDT 1 & 2 (Navy Frogs) and is considered one of the “grandfathers” of today’s Navy SEALs. He was honorably discharged in 1954.

In 1956, he married his sweetheart Mary McCoy in Roseburg, OR. Together they raised 5 boys and the Greenley home was host to many of their sons’ friends.

He worked for several local ranches, retired from Siskiyou Co. Road Dept. Bridge Crew and was very involved in local politics, hunting, fishing and his children’s sports activities.

His is survived by his wife of 59 years, Mary, his brother Bill, and his children:

Alan (Becky), Gordon (Vonnie), James and Michael Herd (Vicky), as well as grandchildren, great-grandchildren, and numerous nieces and nephews.

He was predeceased by his parents, his siblings and his son Rex.
