Florence Rheault, age 99, passed away on Tuesday, October 7, 2014 at Madrone Hospice in Yreka.

On April 10, 1915 in Lowell, Massachusetts, a baby girl was born to Alphonse and Alvina Larose. The third oldest of eighteen children, she was named Florence.

Until 1957 when she, her husband and daughter moved to Covina, California, she worked in the woolen Mills in both Massachusetts and New Hampshire. Her last 20 years of work was at the City of Hope Medical Center in Duarte, California.

After retiring, she and her husband moved to Yreka where she has resided for 35 years. She was a member of St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Yreka. Her activities included senior aerobics, line dancing, Tai Chi, bingo, walking, word search puzzles and playing cards. Once a month for eight years, she and her husband took a weekend bus trip to Reno. Although Florence was not into gambling, she enjoyed the beautiful scenery and shopping.

Her husband, Theodore (Ted), passed away December 19, 2005. She is survived by her daughter, Pauline Rheault; two sisters and a brother, Irene, Doris and Walter Larose of Dracut Massachusetts; a sister-in-law, Aline

Larose also of Dracut, Massachusetts; and numerous nieces and nephews.

She was predeceased by her siblings, Henry, Eugene, Raymond, Alphonse Jr., Armand, Marie, Gertrude, Rose, Simonne, Alice and Rita, along with young girls and a baby boy.
