November 6, 1943 - May 6, 2017

Floyd McCurdy, age 73, passed away peacefully in his sleep due to lung cancer on May 6, 2017. He was born in Forest Grove, Oregon in 1943 to Richard and Theresa McCurdy, and grew up with his brother, Dickie, and sister, Pat. The family moved to different towns in California, and eventually settled in Yreka to build a successful business, High Ridge Lumber Mill, which Floyd later managed. At its peak, the mill employed 150 men, running day and night shifts. Floyd married the “love-of-his-life,” Susan, in 1988, and together they enjoyed an active life of gardening, traveling, gambling, and doting on family. Floyd was an avid outdoorsman. As a young man, he spent much of his free time packing horses, camping, fishing, and hunting in the mountains. He was an accomplished landscaper. He designed his “dream house,” a sprawling Spanish-style villa in Montague and later created a mini-wonderland in his backyard to entertain friends and family and delight every child that ventured outside.

Floyd is survived by his wife Susan, his son Joe (Lisa), his daughter Paige Foust, granddaughter Falyn, grandson Cormac, granddaughter Katy, grandson Tyler, step-son Bill Mittan (Shellee), Ciara, Delaney (Rodney), step-daughter Pam Rimmer (Dan), Teal, Colby, great grandchildren Isaiah, Henlee, and Jade.
