Longtime Scott Valley resident Forest Eldon Short passed away on September 9, 2015 at Rogue Valley Medical Facility in Medford, Oregon. He was 94 years old.

Forest was born March 10, 1921 in Wichita, Kansas to James and Eva Short. He graduated from Orange High School. In 1942 he married Elois Heinemann, a fellow alumnus of Orange High School. Forest worked for Coca-Cola for 42 years, starting as a salesman then eventually into transportation and delivery. Forest and Elois moved to Greenview in 1986.
