October 10, 1933 - June 2, 2020

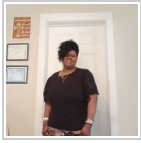
Longtime Yreka resident Franklin DeLano Mayo passed away on June 2, 2020 at his home surrounded by his family. He was 86 years old.

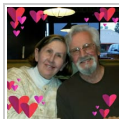
