November 1, 1942 - June 11, 2019

Longtime Grenada resident, George William Hurd, passed away on June 11, 2019 after a short battle with lung cancer. He was 76 years old, and had lived in Grenada for 35 years.

George was born in Sacramento to Edward and Hellen Hurd on November 1, 1942. As a child, he worked with his father in horse logging and in his adolescence, worked with his Uncle Francis Lardie as a firefighter, and was always the one to crawl into the tight spaces because of his small stature!

On June 15, 1985, George married Ruth Bowen, nee Suter at the Grenada Berean Church. The couple would have celebrated their 34th wedding anniversary last weekend. For many years, George ran his own tow truck company in Canyonville, Oregon before moving to Siskiyou County. He then worked in maintenance for the Best Western Miner's Inn for 18 years. George was also a longtime member of the Grenada Fire Department. He enjoyed hunting, fishing, and camping in his spare time – his favorite spots were in the mountains outside of Modesto, or anywhere he and Ruth would venture. He also enjoyed gold mining in the Klamath River. He never found much, but he sure had a good time while looking!

George was preceded in death by his parents, 3 brothers, 4 sisters, and two children. He is survived by his loving wife, Ruth; two sisters, Peggy Gold of

Turlock, and Patsy Davis of Arkansas, and several nieces and nephews.
