



## George Morimasa Okamoto

February 2, 1940 - November 7, 2016

76 year old Yreka resident George Morimasa Okamoto passed away on November 7, 2016 at his home. George was a 9 year resident of Siskiyou County.

George was born on February 2, 1940 to Hidezo and Ruby Okamoto in Los Angeles. He volunteered for Naval Service in 1958, and served until 1979, having served several tours of duty in Vietnam. He eventually retired from the U.S. Navy as a chief legal officer.

George worked for years in Orange County before moving to Siskiyou County in 2007, where he put his pure heart to work: he was a cat lover, and rescued many animals over the years. He was most known for volunteering at the Yreka Senior Center – even though he wasn't a senior! George always gave his time and energy to causes he felt for; whenever somebody needed help, George was there. He was loving, caring, giving, and a pure example of charity. He walked upright, justly, and was as pure hearted man as one could find. It was his kindness that he was known for, and not his cooking, as George was a self-admitted “bad cook.”
