In 2018 she was awarded the 'Yreka Citizen of the Year' for her work with PURR-ANGELS!

Gloria is survived by her daughter, Lynn Hargis; her grandchildren, Misty Partello and Jonathan Chandler; and her great-grandchildren Chandler Partello, Collin Partello, and Julian Chandler. She is also survived by her closest friends, Barbara Villarreal, Pat Hamilton, Denise Patterson, Maggie Harris and Jan Sinnott, all from her PURR-ANGELS family, plus many more whose lives she touched through her love of cats and spay/neuter. Gloria's legacy of kindness and her devotion to both her family and her cause will be remembered and cherished by all who knew her.
