Gregory Thomas Colt was born in Auburn, California of Jess and Verna Colt. He was raised and worked on the Sullivan Pear Ranch while attending Placer High School and graduating from Placer College. There he met his high school sweetheart, Dian Bisson. He was a standout student, band member and star athlete and would later play football at UCLA under Red Sanders. He and Dian were married in Calistoga, March 2, 1952.

Greg spent most of his years as a business man in Yreka. He managed the Sprouse Reitz Store before purchasing Pedersen's Men's Store, which in later years became Greg's Men's Store on Miner St. It was later to be known as Greg's Guys & Gals on Broadway and Lane Street as the center of fashion in Yreka for the next 20 years.

Greg never met a stranger and was a friend to many. He was a volunteer Yreka fireman; member of the Grand Jury and member of the Yreka Elks Foundation.

He was proud of his family, an avid outdoorsman, loved to fish and hunt and

shared many outdoor adventures with his family and fishing and hunting buddies.

He is survived by his loving wife of 69 years, Dian; children Michael Colt (Gail), Debbie Timothy (Andy), and Jenny Parker (Bob); grandsons Kris Colt (Jody), CJ Colt (Katy) and Cade Parker; seven great grandchildren and many nieces and nephews. He now joins great grandson Joshua to rest in heaven and will be deeply missed by his family.
