



## Harriette Elizabeth Wrede James

September 23, 1935 - January 4, 2018

Harriette Wrede James, age 82, of Yreka, California went to be with her Lord and Savior on January 4, 2018. Harriette was born in Pasadena, California to Harry and Margaret (Spang) Wrede on September 23, 1935 and moved to Yreka at the age of 13. Harriette graduated from Yreka High School in 1953.

After a short stint as a bookkeeper at Bank of America in Yreka, Harriette soon realized her dreams of travel and adventure would require a change of careers. She was accepted into the Registered Nursing program at Samuel Merritt School of Nursing in Oakland, California in 1954 and graduated in 1957. Harriette began a long career that spanned two countries and six states including California, Idaho, Virginia, Maryland, Hawaii, Alabama, with a total of eight years in Germany. In addition to being a conscientious healthcare giver, Harriette brought a light-hearted sense of humor wherever she worked. After retiring to Alabama in 1997, Harriette was drawn back to Yreka in 2000 after meeting the love of her life, Harry James.
