



## Hartman Henry Dick

September 8, 1919 - July 26, 2015

Lifelong Yreka resident Hartman Henry Dick passed away July 26, 2015 at Madrone Hospice. He was 95 years old.

Hartman was born September 8, 1919 in Yreka at a hospital which was located where Weldon's Tire Shop is currently located. He is survived by five nieces and seven nephews. Louise, from Portland, Oregon, and Jeane, from Wenatchee, Washington, were frequent visitors of their "Uncle Buddy," and those visits became more frequent in his declining years. His cousins, Frank and Lynda Hovanec, Krystal and Cory were blessed with his companionship throughout his entire life. Several years ago, the Meek family nicknamed him "Hick," and that remained with him always.

After graduating from Yreka High School, Hick joined the U.S. Navy for six years. He was at Pearl Harbor from the outset of the attack. His stories of the attack remained vivid to him and he related them to anyone that cared to ask him. After World War II, he returned to Yreka. Through the years he worked as a carpenter and was involved in the construction of the Klamath River Bridge. He remained a tried and true bachelor his entire life and will always be remembered for his "total" independence. One of his favorite pastimes in his younger years was playing cards at Con Browns. Through the years he could always be seen "holding up" the parking meters as he so enjoyed being a "social" part of the town he so dearly loved. Hunting and fishing were a very

important part of his life, as was watching football and baseball. He was blessed with a “razor” sharp memory and all of us so enjoyed his many tales of years gone by. He was a very “disciplined” gambler, and frequented Reno for several years. When the trip became too much of a hardship, he played Keno and lotto tickets, which truly were his favorite pastime. He always remained a very “guarded” player and enjoyed doing so thoroughly. The Senior Center was his daily outing for over 30 years, enjoying their wonderful lunches.
