



Hazelbelle Krentz Moore

October 1, 1924 - June 17, 2021

Longtime Callahan resident Hazelbelle Krentz Moore passed away on June 17, 2021 at her home in Callahan. She was 96 years old.

Hazelbelle was born on October 1, 1924 in Ashland, Illinois. She grew up in San Bernardino, and graduated from San Bernardino High School in 1942, where she met her soon-to-be husband, Stanley Moore. They were wed in the summer of 1942. In 1950 they moved with his parents, George and Isabelle Moore, to Callahan. Together they purchased the Messner Ranch and continued to live there to the present.

The United Methodist Church was a big part of Hazelbelle's life. She was a member of the United Methodist Women's group and an integral part of keeping the church going and helped with many dinners coming together smoothly. The 4-H allowed her to share her love for sewing as a county and local leader, as well as home decorations. She served as a volunteer at Siskiyou General Hospital (now Fairchild Medical Center) Auxiliary for 20 years. Traveling was a passion for her, and many trips were taken in her Tioga van all over the United States, usually by herself. She also visited Germany, the Netherlands, Sweden and Australia.

Hazelbelle is survived by her sons, Timothy Moore and his wife Nancy Cooperrider of Juneau, Alaska, and Richard Moore and his wife Rosemary of

Callahan; grandchildren Matthew Moore (Maria) of Arizona, Robert Moore (Amanda) of Callahan, and Sarah Cooperrider Moore (Mikko Wilson) of Juneau; and a great grandson, Desten Moore of Callahan. She was preceded in death by her husband of 64 years, Stanley Moore, a sister Pauline Durrington, a brother, Arnold Moore, and her parents, Alfred and Hazel Krentz. A special thanks goes to her long term caregiver, Michele Estrada, who was a big part of keeping Hazelbelle at home.
