



Henry Hideo Nonaka

March 18, 1943 - July 2, 2016

Henry Hideo Nonaka, longtime Illinois resident, passed away on July 2, 2016 at the Lava Beds National Monument near Tulelake, California. He was 73 years old.

Henry was born on March 18, 1943 to Chitoshi and Sueko (Yuoka) Nonaka at the Tulelake Internment Camp in Tulelake. After the war, Henry and his family moved to Chicago, where Henry graduated from Lane Technical High School and received a Bachelor of Science in Chemistry from the University of Chicago. Henry and his wife, Gail, were lifelong employees of Corn Products International. Henry was an avid world-wide traveler and had visited all seven continents. He was also a lifelong, long-suffering Chicago Cubs fan!

Henry is survived by his wife, Gail; his children, Jason, Fawn and Ben; two brothers, Sam and John; and four grandchildren, Sam, Henry, Eden and Dorothy. He was preceded in death by his brother, Jim. Henry was a beloved uncle to many, and fond cousin of the Ikeda, Inaba and Befu families.
