Irene M. Holloway was born on August 20, 1930 to William and Clara Bowman of Likely, CA. She grew up in Modoc County and lived on the family farm.

Her first job was as a manual "pin-setter" in the local bowling alley. What a noisy job that must have been! She also worked as an usherette at the movie theater. She met her future husband, Adrian Holloway, at a football game where she was a Yell Leader for Modoc High School. They married October 29, 1947, in Reno, Nevada. They resided in Canby, CA, for many years. Adrian was the Planerman at the sawmill and she was a homemaker. Together they raised three children, Casey, Sharon and Lynn. In 1964 they moved to Yreka. Adrian began a career with Pine Mountain Lumber Co. Irene was an excellent seamstress and frequently made clothes for her children and their cousins. She took many quilting classes and made fabulous quilts. She even won Reserve Best of Show with one quilt entry at Shasta District Fair. She was an avid reader and loved learning and using newly discovered vocabulary words. Irene and Adrian often went camping at Lake Shasta and Crescent City. She loved flowers and gardening. She would share the tomatoes she grew with the neighborhood. Her sewing abilities led to a job with Maxine's Draperies for several years. After that she was employed at James Place Antiques. She loved collecting antiques herself, especially cranberry glass. At various times, she did volunteer work at the

library, was a literacy coach, senior citizen tax preparer, and thrift store clerk.

In 2018, she moved to Redding, CA. She passed from this earth on August 9, 2022. She was preceded in death by her parents, William and Clara Bowman, her husband, Adrian, and her siblings, Sherman, Bertha, Kenneth and Joyce. She leaves behind her children Casey Holloway, Sharon Dodson-Olson (husband Robert), and Lynn Forero (husband Larry), 8 grandchildren and 8 great-grandchildren.
