She first came to Klamath River in 1954 with her husband and four young children. The ranch at Doggett Creek became their lifelong home. They became part of Horse Creek Community Church and supported the work of the church in many ways through the years. Her life has been devoted to her children and grandchildren. She and Dick spent many of their retirement years traveling throughout the United States and Canada with their RV.
