



Jacqueline Mae Jaeger

Jacqueline Mae (Diehl) Jaeger passed into glory on Friday April 13, 2012. Her secure faith from childhood to grave buoyed her in the knowledge that by grace she was saved and death was a joy because it meant she would see her Savior face-to-face.

Jacqueline was born in Illinois in 1925, married to Harold Jaeger in 1942. Harold and Jacque moved to Yreka in 1984 having lived in Illinois, Utah, Arizona, and other residences in California. Her husband died in 1989. She is survived by her daughter, Sharon Jaeger of Mission Viejo, CA, and her husband Jim Farber; son, Michael Jaeger, of La Grande, OR, and his wife Marilyn; three grandchildren, Aaron Jaeger of Poway, CA, Eli Jaeger of Seattle, WA, and Amy Hall of Olathe, KS; and eight great grandchildren.

Jacqueline loved many things: Tending the “Jaeger’s Acres” garden; decorating the house for each season and entertaining friends, family and visitors; cooking; sewing and quilting; antiquing; and exploring the county and enjoying the sights and seasons of Yreka. Her passions were serving in the Grenada Community Berean Church on the missions team, in AWANA, in women’s ministry, as a family counselor, and as a Bible Study leader. In the community she served as a child support advocate and was, for many years, an active member of the South Yreka Firemen’s Auxiliary.

Jacqueline’s professional career spanned 5 decades, serving several churches in California as a staff associate. She was nationally certified as a Christian Counselor and donated her time and expertise to the Grenada

Community Berean Church. Her educational background was from several colleges and universities including California State University at Redlands, Northridge and Long Beach, as well as Concordia College.
