



Jason Allen Martin

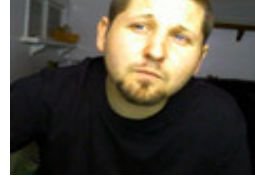
May 12, 1983 - May 12, 2023
