



Jean Addison Lovelace

February 7, 1927 - March 5, 2014

Longtime Yreka resident, Jean Lovelace, passed away on Wednesday, March 5, 2014, at Fairchild Medical Center. She was 87 years old.

Jean was born to William and Alice Smith on February 7, 1927, in Sale Cheshire, England. After growing up in England, Jean became a British War Bride when she married Donald Addison, a Sergeant with the United States Army during World War II. After the war, she left her family in England and moved to Salem, Oregon with her husband. The couple resided in Salem from 1946-1969. At that time, they moved to Phoenix, Oregon, and then to Yreka in 1970. Jean and Donald owned Siskiyou Vending until Donald's death in 1972. Jean was an active member in the Stella Chapter #39, Order of the Eastern Star, of Yreka, the Daughters of the Nile, and Daughters of the British Empire. Jean was known for her amazing knitting skills, her love of reading, and her love for coffee.

Jean was preceded in death by her husband, Donald Addison and her second husband, Gordon Lovelace.
