



## Jennie Dilley

March 13, 1923 - December 17, 2014

Longtime Yreka resident, Jennie Dilley, passed away on December 17, 2014 at her home. She was 91 years old.

Jennie was born on March 13, 1923 to Richard and Rosebud Worrell in Hot Springs, Arkansas. Jennie was a proud veteran of the United States Marine Corps during World War II. She moved to Siskiyou County in 1971, and became an avid member of the First Baptist Church in Yreka. She stayed active in the local Marine Corps League, and also joined the Elkettes, the Fairchild Medical Auxillary, Hospital Guild, and was a member of the Welcome Wagon. She served on the Mt. Shasta Area Council Hospital Volunteers for several years, and also served on the California Association of Hospital & Health Systems Committee on Volunteers. Jennie and her late husband, Arch, were former owners of Quigley's Store in Klamath River. Jennie also spent 15 years prior to retiring as the Postmaster for Ft. Jones Post Office. No matter her profession or how busy she was, she always found time for quilting, as that was her favorite hobby.

Jennie was preceded in death by her husband, Arch, in 1987, and her son John "Pat" Dilley. She is survived by her son, Craig Dilley, of Boston, and three grandchildren: Brittany, Michelle, and Jacob Dilley.
