Joanne Elizabeth Eastlick, 80 year old long time Scott Valley resident, passed away Tuesday morning, January 27, 2015 at her home in Quartz Valley following a short illness. Joanne was born November 7, 1934 in San Jose to Evald and Eunice Lindholm. She was a descendant of Jacob Conner, an original gold miner to Scott Valley in 1850.

Near the end of Joanne's 3rd year at San Jose State, she married Rodney D. Eastlick on August 6, 1955 in Reno, Nev. and the couple settled in Quartz Valley. Joanne was a member of the Alpha Phi Sorority. She worked for many years as a teacher's aide at the Quartz Valley elementary school. Joanne was a wonderful mother and loving wife who enjoyed reading, loving on and raising her four sons, grandkids and great grandkids.
