Today we bid you farewell. We are all devastated not to be able to attend the ceremony in Yreka, but our thoughts will be with you at the time the ceremony starts. When your remains are back in the Netherlands we will hold a memorial service for you to say goodbye personally. You are with Dad again now.

We are proud to have had you as our son, father, brother and uncle.
